The 2019 Pheasant Wood Time Trial Series will be contested over 4 Rounds with points being accumulated for 3 of the 4 rounds. Competitors are therefore able to drop the worst round of points. This means that if you have a bad round or are unable to attend, you still have a great chance at the outright series placing's. Competitors are invited to attend any or all of the above listed rounds. Prizes will be awarded at individual rounds as well as the completion of the series.

The Pheasant Wood Time Trial Series is ideal for all Motor Sport enthusiasts of any driving experience level.

### ENTRY FEE

Time Trial Series Entry Fee is \$170.00 per driver per round if paid by close of entries (saving \$30) or \$200.00 if paid after entries close or on the day. You can pre-pay all 4 rounds with the Round 1 entry at the reduced price of \$510 (saving \$170 on individual entry payments). No refunds will be available; however transfer of entry to a following round of the 2019 Series is available if withdrawal received in writing a minimum of 7 days prior to the event. Pheasant Wood Track Licence Fee \$50.00 (licence is valid for 12 months from date of purchase). Pheasant Wood Licence is not required if you have a valid competition licence, minimum CAMS L2S (this must be presented on the day).

A completed Entry Form and Time Trial Entry Fee must be submitted to Pheasant Wood prior to the event to secure your spot on the day.

# VEHICLE TYPES:

## THE FOLLOWING VEHICLES ARE PERMITTED TO COMPETE AT THIS EVENT

Entry is open to all 4 wheeled vehicles including Street Cars and Race Cars, excluding those listed below. Classes will be determined according to the entries received.

## THE FOLLOWING VEHICLES ARE NOT PERMITTED TO COMPETE AT THIS EVENT

- A. GO-KARTS
- B. SUV'S
- C. QUAD BIKES

## NOISE RESTRICTIONS

Noise restrictions apply and all vehicles must be fitted with an effective Muffler (a hot dog muffler is not an effective muffler). Vehicles must be under 90db at 30 metres.

# CAR REQUIREMENTS

Pre-track vehicle inspection:

- A. NO OIL LEAKS
- B. BATTERY BRACKET IN PLACE
- C. TYRES ARE IN A SAFE CONDITION
- D. EXHAUST SYSTEM/s SECURE
- E. TURBO WASTE GATE PIPES MUST BE PLUMBED INTO EXHAUST
- F. SEAT BELTS MUST BE IN A GOOD CONDITION
- G. ALL LOOSE ITEMS MUST BE REMOVED FROM INSIDE OF CAR
- H. ALL LOOSE ITEMS MUST BE REMOVED FROM BOOT
- I. HUB-CAPS AND WHEEL TRIMS MUST BE REMOVED
- J. FUEL CAPS MUST BE SECURE AND HAVE NO FUEL LEAKS
- K. STANDARD ROAD TYRES MUST HAVE ABOVE 38 POUNDS OF PRESSURE
- L. ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST WEAR AN APPROVED HELMET AND HELMETS MUST BE PROPERLY FASTENED
- M. CLOTHING
  - A) STREET CARS - LONG PANTS, LONG SLEEVES AND CLOSED IN SHOES (JOGGERS)
  - B) RACE CARS – APPROVED RACING APPAREL

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# 2019 MDTC TIME TRIAL SERIES RULES AND REGULATIONS

## 1. Track Density

The maximum entries permitted will be 50. A maximum of 12 vehicles will be on track during any session.

## 2. Licence Requirements

The minimum licence required for this event will be a PHEASANT WOOD Track Licence or valid CAMS L2S licence. A current Pheasant Wood or competition licence must be produced at sign in or a Pheasant Wood Track licence will need to be purchased.

## 3. Participant Sign On

All participants are required to attend the Pheasant Wood Administration Office for document and licence checking purposes. Wrist bands for groups will be distributed during this process.

## 4. Timing

A timing company will be present on the day and each participant will be issued with a timing transponder to ensure accuracy. Results will also be posted on the Natsoft website at [www.natsoft.com.au](http://www.natsoft.com.au)

## 5. Groups

Participants will be placed into groups according to the following:

- a. Practice/Qualifying will be based on experience and vehicle type.
- b. Timed Sessions will be based on times.

## 6. Schedule

The schedule for the event will consist of 2 timed practice sessions and 4 timed sessions. Each timed session will comprise of 7 laps which include pit exit/warm up lap followed by 5 timed laps and pit entry/cool down lap.

## 7. Nomination of Times

At the completion of the qualifying session all participants will be required to nominate your lap time for the timed sessions. Nominations and allocation of revised wrist bands will take place under cover at the front of the Café.

## 8. Point Score

- a. At the start of each session 100 points will be allocated to each participant.
- b. 1 points will be deducted for each  $\frac{1}{4}$  second faster or slower than your nominated time.

## 9. Results

The event winner will be the participant with the most points remaining at the end of the 4 timed sessions. If more than one (1) participant are tied on equal points the final placing's will be decided on the person who has recorded a time closest to their nominated time.

## 10. Awards

Awards will be presented to the first 3 place getters of each class for each Round (excluding any participant of the Quick Time Top 5 Shoot Out)

## 11. Quick Time Top 5 Shoot Out

The Quick Time Top 5 Shoot Out will take place following the completion of the Time Trial scheduled sessions. The quickest time recorded during the day will earn the driver a place in the Top 5. Competitors can opt out of the Shoot Out and the next placed Quick Time will be invited to compete.

## 12. Presentation/Awards

Any competitor who is not present at the presentation and is due to receive an Award, agrees that by not attending the presentation, they may forfeit their Award and the Award may be given to the next placing

competitor who is present at the presentation. Awards will not be held or sent out to competitors not attending the presentation.
